CODE OF CONDUCT

We are very fortunate to be able to play the game we all love. In doing so, there is an expectation of behaviour that is mandatory. A condition of playing is that players agree to abide by the expectations and rules below. Any infractions can result in a temporary or permanent expulsion from playing with the group.

Goals:

The goals of this hockey are to have fun, be competitive, get some exercise, enjoy some comradery, and work on our skills.

Core Principles:

The core principles are safety first, respect for all and a display good sportsmanship at all times. Players must be at least 50 years old.

Behavioral Expectations of Players:

- No demonstration of poor sportsmanship, tossing sticks in frustration or delaying/interrupting games.
- No fighting.
- No physical or verbal abuse or harassment.
- Do not play if you are unwell, impaired or under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- Refrain from using foul language, ridiculing teammates, or engaging in behavior that spoils the activity for everyone.
- Respect the property of others and leave facilities in good condition.

Playing Rules:

As there are no referees, players are responsible for managing their own on-ice game behavior and performance. This includes:

- No checking, high-sticking or aggressive play that may result in injury.
- No slapshots.
- No play in the blue paint.
- Observe offsides.
- Play by the rules of the game and in the spirit of the game.

By coming out to play, all players hereby agree to abide by the above expectations and rules.
